2023 INFANT OBSERVATION SEMINARS

The capacity to observe is central to the practice of therapy.

The privilege of observing an infant in the care of their parent in the home environment for the first one to two years of life offers a unique education in observing which underpins the therapist's work, providing experience in dealing with the internal states which emerge for therapist and patient in clinical work. This Infant Observation experience provides a great deal more than can be obtained by reading or lectures and leads to internal growth of the observer as well as benifitting the baby and their parent.

Completing a one or two year Infant Observation is an integral component of the QPPA training, however an Infant Observation can be undertaken by any clinician , potential clinician and people working closely with children and adults such as teachers, nurses, day care workers and others.
